The Burgundy Squid Cafe & Craft Shoppe

The Burgundy Squid Cafe & Craft Shoppe is located in a 100 year old heritage fishing stage just west of the bridge across the Main Tickle that separates the North and South islands of Change Islands; a picturesque Newfoundland island fishing community in the North Atlantic just



one hour North of Gander.

There is a 350' boardwalk linking the Burgundy Squid Café & Craft Shoppe and the Torrville heritage cottage. Attached to the boardwalk is a 16'x12' flake built out over the water. It is a wonderful deck to observe the boat traffic along the Main Tickle and watch sunsets. Under-
