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The Torrville Heritage Cottage

The Torrville Heritage Cottage, centrally located with a commanding view of the Main Tickle of the outpost community of Change Islands, is available for weekly rent.

The cottage is located just west of the bridge across the Main Tickle that separates the North and South islands of Change Islands and is only 100 feet from the shoreline. The Andrew Bown General Store, a third generation family business, is located just minutes away on the South island and the recently restored Walter Torrville Fishing Stage and Wharf is located just southeast of the Cottage. The Post Office and Medical Clinic are located next door on Tickle Point Road.

Rental Details & Rates

The cottage is fully equipped and has 2 bedrooms, kitchen, dining room, living room and full bathroom. It has a beautiful view of the Main Tickle from the veranda. A stove, refrigerator, washer, dryer and full electric heating are included.

There is a 350' boardwalk from the cottage to the Burgundy Squid Café & Craft Shoppe, located in the restored Walter Torrville fishing stage. The Café is open from 10 am–8 pm every day, and serves brunch, lunch and light evening meals.

In front of the cottage boardwalk is a 16'x12' flake built out over the water. It is a wonderful deck to observe the boat traffic along the Main Tickle and watch sunsets. Underneath the flake is a landing beach and storage facility for kayaks.

The rental rate for the Torrville Heritage Cottage is \$560 per week. Please contact us for reservations.
